LIGHTLY DRAW A GUIDELINE TO PLACE SHAGGY'S UPPER BODY. ADD AN OVAL FOR HIS HEAD AND GUIDELINES FOR HIS FEATURES. DRAW CIRCLES FOR HIS SHOULDERS, ELBOWS AND KNEES. THEN LIGHTLY SKETCH THE BASIC SHAPES OF HIS SHIRT, PANTS AND SHOES.



ADD HIS MOP OF SHAGGY HAIR. NEXT SKETCH THE OUTLINES OF HIS FEATURES AND ADD BAGGY SLEEVES ON HIS ARMS. THEN START LIGHTLY REFINING ALL YOUR OUTLINES.



NOW SKETCH IN THE LITTLE DETAILS THAT MAKE SHAGGY COMPLETE, INCLUDING SEVERAL SHORT WHISKERS ON HIS CHIN.
